

Protect Your Child Through Prayer





I. Lead your Child to Christ

- Pray for your child's salvation.
- Tell stories
- Give a simple gospel presentation
- Give a clear invitation
- Review his / her decision

II. Put Christ at the Centre of your Home

- Your words and example should clearly testify that Jesus Christ is the Lord of your life.



III. Establish consistent Family Devotion

- Family devotions should be brief and simple, especially with young children.
- Look for creative ways to impart biblical truths during devotions.

V. Celebrate Each Child's Uniqueness

- The healthy Christian home is one where differences in appearance, ability and performance are not allowed to be a source of divisiveness.
- Each child must be accepted for who he is and encouraged to celebrate his own uniqueness as a child of God.

- Set aside one mealtime each week or month to **honor a child**.
- Another way to celebrate the uniqueness of your kids is to show a genuine interest in their activities.



VI. Maintain an Environment of Love and Forgiveness.

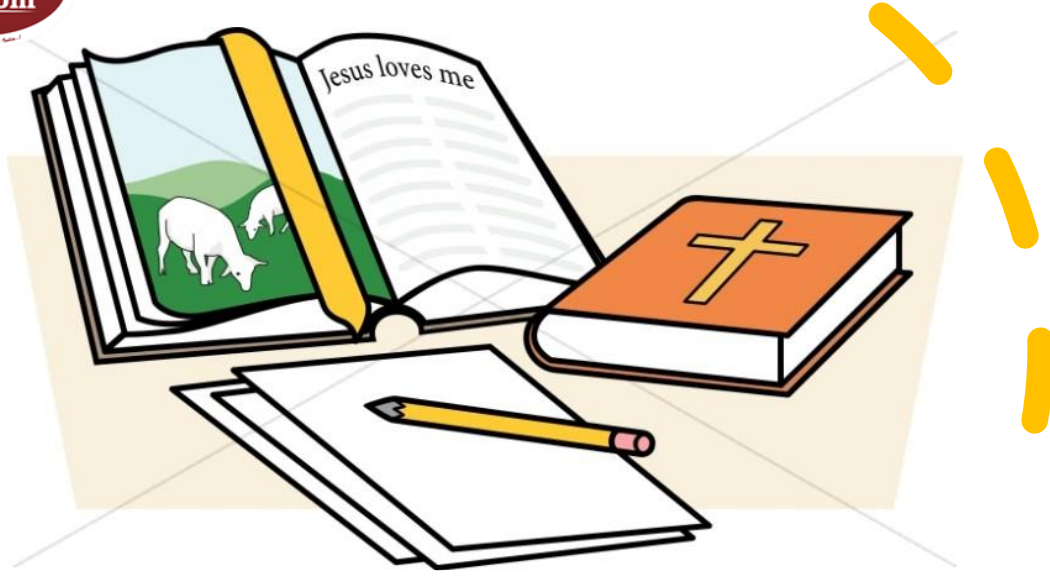
✓ Time together communicates love.

▪ **Keep a family diary.**

- The Prayer diary is something tangible in your home to remind your child that God hears and answer prayers.

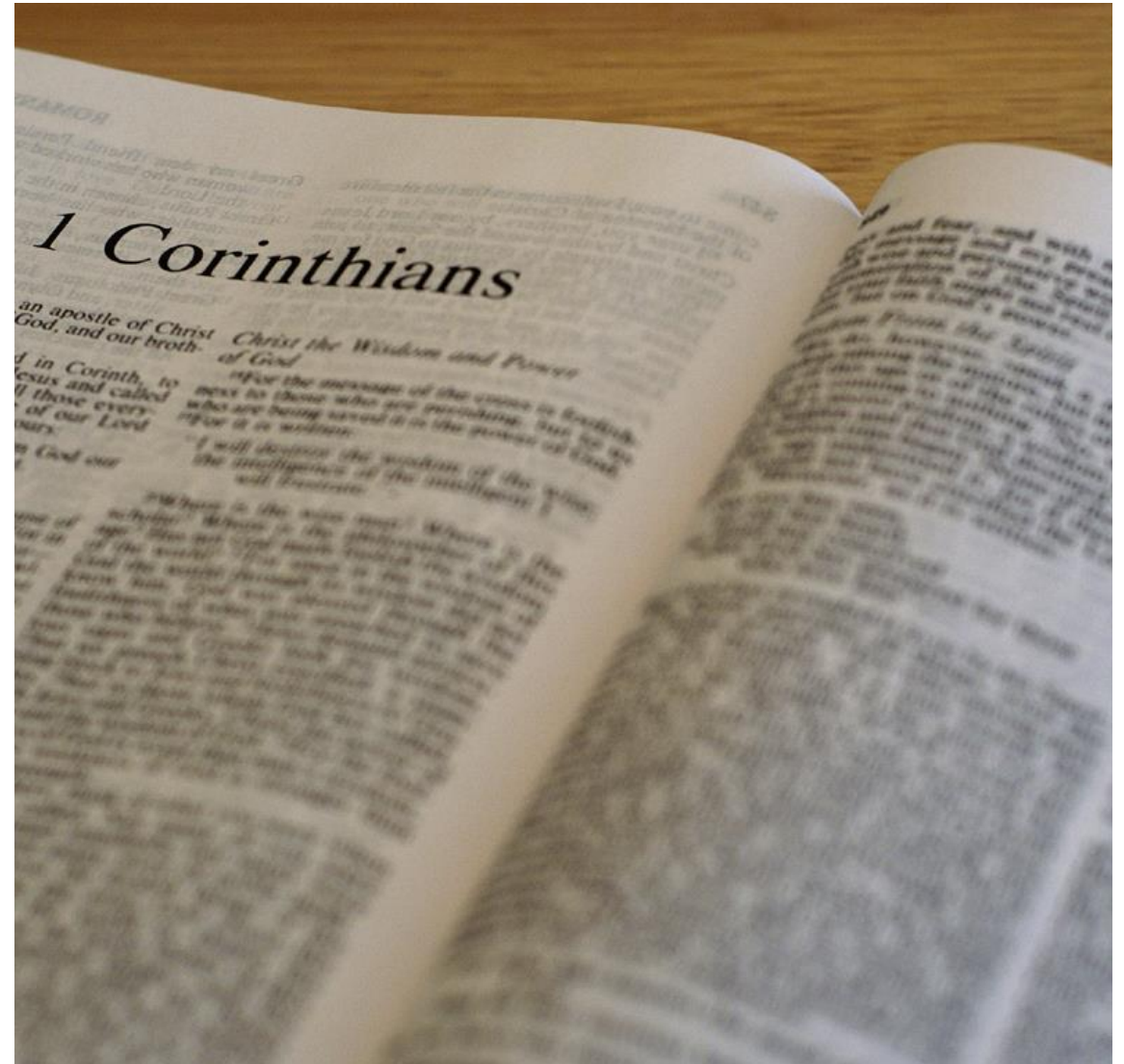

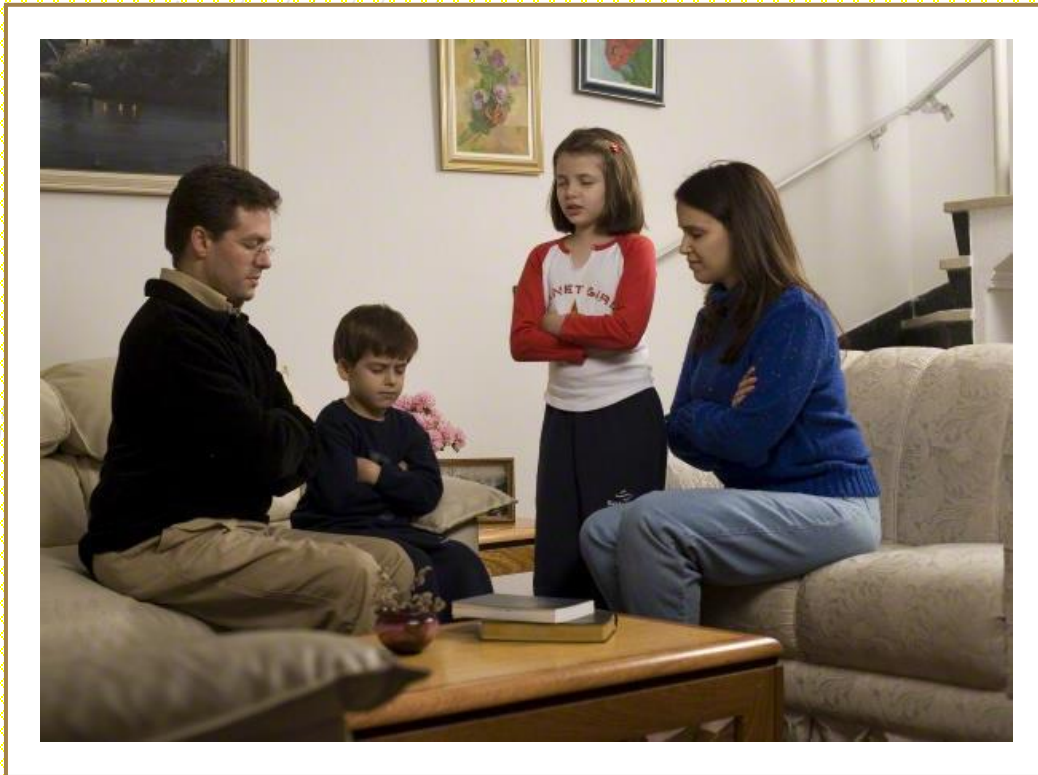

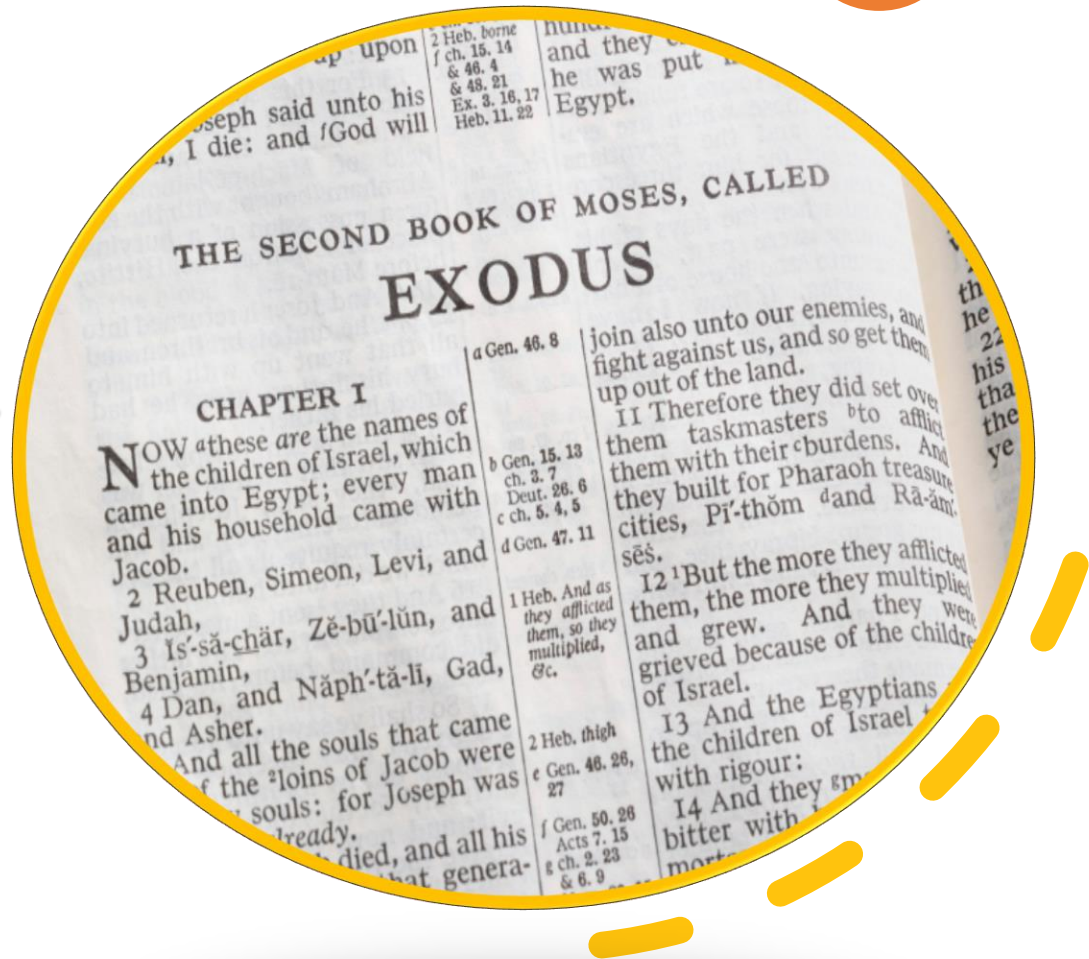
